14 Describe the organizational action and, if applicable, the date of the action or the date against which shareholders' ownership is measured for the action ▶ ON OCTOBER 25, 2017, THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS FOR CARRIAGE SERVICES, INC. APPROVED AN INCREASE IN THE QUARTERLY CASH DIVIDEND ON COMMON STOCK FROM \$0.05 TO \$0.075 PER SHARE. THE INCREASE WAS EFFECTIVE WITH RESPECT TO THE DIVIDEND PAYABLE ON MARCH 2, 2020 TO HOLDERS OF RECORD ON FEBRUARY 10, 2020 (EX-DIVIDEND DATE OF FEBRUARY 7, 2020). THE CASH DIVIDEND PAID ON COMMON STOCK RESULTED IN A CONVERSION RATE CHANGE ON CARRIAGE'S 2.750% CONVERTIBLE SENIOR NOTES DUE 2021.

15 Describe the quantitative effect of the organizational action on the basis of the security in the hands of a U.S. taxpayer as an adjustment per share or as a percentage of old basis ▶ THE TAXABLE AMOUNT OF THE DEEMED DISTRIBUTION THAT RESULTED FROM THE CONVERSION RATE CHANGE INCREASED THE BASIS OF THE NOTES IN THE HANDS OF THE NOTEHOLDERS BY \$2.2801 PER \$1,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE NOTES HELD ON FEBRUARY 10, 2020. THE CONVERSION RATE INCREASED FROM 45.4615 COMMON SHARES PER \$1,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE NOTES, TO 45.5554 COMMON SHARES PER \$1,000 PRINCIPAL AMOUNT OF THE NOTES. CARRIAGE SERVICES' SHARES ARE PUBLICALLY TRADED UNDER TICKER SYMBOL "CSV". PER SHARE FAIR MARKET VALUE OF \$24.26 IS THE AVERAGE STOCK PRICE ON THE LAST TEN DAYS PRIOR TO FEBRUARY 7, 2020.

**Adjusted conversion rate calculation for increase in dividend payment**

(d) *Adjustment for Cash Distributions.* If the Ex-Dividend Date occurs for any cash dividend or distribution by the Company to all or substantially all holders of the outstanding Common Stock, other than regular quarterly cash dividends that do not exceed \$0.025 per share (such threshold, the "Initial Dividend Threshold"), the Conversion Rate shall be adjusted based on the following formula:

$$CR_1 = CR_0 \times \frac{SP_0 - T}{SP_0 - C}$$

where:

CR<sub>0</sub> = the Conversion Rate in effect immediately prior to the Open of Business on the Ex-Dividend Date for such dividend or distribution;

CR<sub>1</sub> = the Conversion Rate in effect immediately after the Open of Business on the Ex-Dividend Date for such dividend or distribution;

SP<sub>0</sub> = the average of the Last Reported Sale Prices of the Common Stock over the ten consecutive Trading Day period ending on, and including, the Trading Day immediately preceding the Ex-Dividend Date for such dividend or distribution;

T = the Initial Dividend Threshold; *provided*, that if the dividend or distribution is not a regular quarterly dividend, the Initial Dividend Threshold will be deemed to be zero; and

C = the amount in cash per share that the Company pays or distributes to holders of the Common Stock.

The Initial Dividend Threshold is subject to adjustment in a manner inversely proportional to adjustments to the Conversion Rate, other than any adjustment provided for in this Section 10.05(d).

If "SP<sub>0</sub>" (as defined above) minus "C" (as defined above) is less than \$1.00, in lieu of the foregoing adjustment, each Holder shall receive, for each \$1,000 principal amount of Notes held, at the same time and upon the same terms as holders of the Common Stock, the amount of cash such Holder would have received if such Holder had owned a number of shares of the Common Stock equal to the Conversion Rate in effect on the record date for such distribution.

Any adjustment made under this Section 10.05(d) shall become effective immediately after the Open of Business on the Ex-Dividend Date for such distribution. If such distribution is not so paid or made, the Conversion Rate shall be immediately readjusted, as of the date the Board of Directors determines not to make or pay such distribution, to be the Conversion Rate that would then be in effect had the related Ex-Dividend Date not occurred.
