Capital Group International, Inc. does not have investment power or voting power over any of the securities reported herein; however, Capital Group International, Inc. may be deemed to "beneficially own" such securities by virtue of Rule 13d-3 under the Act.

Capital Guardian Trust Company, a bank as defined in Section 3(a)6 of the Act is deemed to be the beneficial owner of 2,174,000 shares or 15.9% of the 13,702,000 shares of Class A Common Stock believed to be outstanding as a result of its serving as the investment manager of various institutional accounts.
